"What are the blue numbers and grid lines on this map?"

This map is displaying the United States National Grid (USNG), which provides a national "language of location" in an easy to read format. The USNG is the Military Grid Referencing System (MGRS), found on most GPS receivers.

For more info:

The main purpose of USNG is to be used in case of emergency. You'll see blue USNG signs on the trail at various locations which, in case of emergency, will help emergency workers know where you are (call 911). If you know where you are on the map, the grid will give your location if a USNG sign is not close. You can also correlate a sign with the map to find your location.
