

The Silver Bay area is in the center of excellent opportunities to exercise. One can walk and bike in the City itself. Check out the Silver Bay Walking Map for loops and mileage.

The Superior Hiking Trail is a nationally acclaimed trail. It contains over 280 miles of trails through the North Shore. The local trailhead is on Penn Avenue, just west of town, but the trail can also be accessed through the Twin Lakes Spur Trail at the Historical Society on Outer Drive. See the larger map for details.

The Gitchi Gami biking, walking, and inline skating trail that more or less parallels Highway 61 from Beaver Bay to Gooseberry State Park, 14 miles away, is completely paved. Soon the Beaver Bay to Silver Bay segment will be constructed.

In the winter, Northwoods Ski Trail has 28 kilometers of meticulously groomed classic single track trails.
