

R E S O L U T I O N - 2001 - #26

Abolishing the Police Civil Service Commission

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it should exercise a greater role in the employment, promotion, discharge, and suspension of officers and employees of the police department and in the opinion of the department, and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that more direct management by the Council will promote greater efficiency and allow for better control of the police department budget and expenditures, and

WHEREAS, the policy would be more consistent with management of other departments within the City,

BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 419.16, that the Police Civil Service Commission for the City of Silver Bay, be and hereby is abolished.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Section 230.13 of the Silver Bay City Code establishing a Police Civil Service Commission is repealed.

Adopted this 20th day of August, 2001, by unanimous vote of the City Council, at a regular meeting of the Council.
