

**SILVER BAY CITY CODE
CHAPTER 3 AMENDMENT**

The City Council of the City of Silver Bay ordains as follows:

Chapter 3, Section 320.06 of the City Code is amended to read as follows:

320.06 Attendance of Peace Officer: It shall be the responsibility of the Permittee of a public dance to maintain peace and good order at all public dances. The Chief of Police may require that a peace officer designated by the Chief be in attendance at a public dance. The peace officer need not be a Police Officer of the City Police Department and shall act as a special deputy for the limited purpose of maintenance of peace and good order. The peace officer shall have the authority to call upon the City Police or other law enforcement officers for assistance and for taking persons who may be charged with an offense into custody. The Chief of Police may require City Police Officers on duty to make periodic inspections of public dances to assure that good order is being maintained and City Ordinances and State Statutes complied with.

Effective date: This Amendment to the City Code shall take effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
