

CITY CODE, CHAPTER 9, AMENDMENT

The City Council of the City of Silver Bay ordains that Chapter 9, Section 920, of the Silver Bay City Code is amended adding paragraph B. to Section 920.03 as follows:

**920.03 Driveway Approach - Requirements.**

**B. Each lot which abuts one or more public streets shall be entitled to at least one access to a public street. Lots in R-1 zoning districts as defined in City Code Section 12 shall be limited to one (1) driveway access per lot.**

**RESOLUTION AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 920.03**

**WHEREAS**, the Silver Bay Planning and Zoning Commission, for the safety of the traveling public, and for cost and convenience of street maintenance and repair, has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to limit driveway access in noncommercial zoning districts as defined in City Code Chapter 12 to one driveway access per lot; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended that the City Council amend City Code Chapter 9, Section 920.03, to adopt this driveway provision; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council having reviewed the Planning and Zoning Commission's recommendation and fully considered the matter, takes the following action:
